Camp Leo, ConnecT1D and Type 1 United Apple Sale 2022 Frequently Asked Questions August- October 2022

1. What changes are there in the apple sale program for 2022?

- Now \$45 dollars per 40lb box of apples (that is only \$1.12 a pound!)
- New pick-up location (see Question 7 below).
- Apple sales profit (\$10) will be donated to support Camp Leo, ConnecT1D and Type 1 United. These funds help keep the cost of programs low and affordable for all (see Question 8 for more information on the change).

2. How do I get involved in the 2022 Apple Sales Program?

- a. Returning Sales people: Market the 2022 Apple Sales to your customer base and use the online form to place order for total # of boxes ordered
- b. New Sales People: Contact programs@t1united.org for more information on how to get started
- c. Individual Purchasers: Use the online ordering form to submit order directly

3. How do I use the online form if I am placing an order for several customers?

- a. Place the order yourself after you have collected the funds from your customers or,
- b. Direct your customers to the form and have them mark yourself as the "Sale's Person" if you are going to be delivering the apples to them.

4. When do I pay Type 1 United for the apples we have sold?

You <u>must</u> provide payment for your apples on the online site or on the day you pick them up.

5. What will these apples look like?

They will be uniform size, washed, graded and packed on trays in a 40 pound bushel box. These are THIS YEAR'S Fuji apples coming from a packing plant in Eastern Washington with Washington apples. They will look like what you get in the grocery store.

6. When do we pick up our apples?

Middle of October. Date to be determined.

7. Where do we pick the apples up?

There will be two pick up locations this year, one in Thurston County and one in Renton. Please indicate the location you would like to pick up on your sales form.

8. Why did the price of the apples increase by \$5?

The price increased because the sponsoring Lions Club has to bring the apples to Olympia already packed. When fruit comes from a packing house it has already been washed, sorted and graded in the packing process. The price of the apples has not been increased since 2018. Given the increases in the cost of food and the cost of fuel over this period, we believe a cost increase of \$5 per box is reasonable. Most importantly, you continue to earn \$10 per box for Camp Leo, ConnecT1D and Type 1 United.

9. Can we use the apple sales as funds to send our camper to camp?

This year the funds raised will support Camp Leo, ConnecT1D and Type 1 United to help bring down overall programing costs for camp. If this will affect your campers ability to attend Camp Leo in 2023, please contact programs@t1united.org
